All extinguishers listed as 'Expired but still charged' are technically out of date (fire extinguishers have a life of only 5ym) however are holding charge and weighing within the cornect parameters.

Should you wish to order replacement the ASE fire extinguishers (Inc. brocket) timough me, this can be organised at a cost of \$20per unit.

CONGRATULATIONS TO HELEN, CHARLIE, PETER AND GRANT FOR BEING THE CLUB MEMBERS WITH A PASSABLE, IN DATE FIRE EXTINGUISHER! WELL DONE!

MOST OTHERS WERE "EXPIRED BUT STILL CHARGED" OR "VERY OLD- NOT UP TO STANDARD, REQUIRES REPLACEMENT". IT IS RECOMMENDED TO REPLACE ALL OF THESE WITH A NEW EXTINGUISHER AS THEY SHOULD BE CHANGED EVERY 5 YEARS.

### 360

The earliest Subarus in Australia were as far back as 1958 when examples of the 360 were imported and distributed by independent dealerships.



### 1000

This was followed by the Subaru 1000 in 1966, introducing the horizontally opposed "Boxer" engine.

### Leone

However, it wasn't until 1973 that a subsidiary Subaru (Aust) Pty Limited was formed and started selling cars directly. The first was the Leone, which was the first Subaru with on-demand four-wheel drive and Subaru's famed symmetrical drive train. It was well-received for its reliability and performance, particularly in rural areas where its 4WD capability proved advantageous.





## **Brumby**

In 1977 the first Brumby was introduced. A two door utility with the same 4WD drivetrain, it became very popular with both rural customers and adventurers and production continued well into the 1990s.

### L Series

Through the 1980s Subaru Australia introduced new models such as the MY, L-Series and Liberty, with a range of body styles including sedans, wagons, and coupes. The Liberty was sold overseas as the Legacy, but that name is associated in Australia with returned soldiers and that name was considered inappropriate here.

## Impreza

In 1993 Subaru introduced the Impreza, basically a replacement for the Leone. It was offered with either front wheel drive or all wheel drive.

### WRX

A performance enhanced variation of the Impreza was developed, the WRX, which was much sought after by enthusiasts. Jumping ahead, the 5<sup>th</sup> generation is now available with 203kW available from its 2.4 litre engine! Returning to our timeline in the 1990's, Subaru Rally Team were excelling, so much so that from 1996 to 2005 they won ten consecutive Australian Rally championships, with the WRX the star.



## **Outback & Forester**

Meanwhile, back with more restrained models, the Outback was released in 1996 and the Forester in 1997. From 1997 Subaru offered only all wheel drive across its entire range, the only car maker to do so at the time.



## Tribeca

In 2006 Subaru's first 7 seat luxury 4WD was introduced, the Tribeca. However, sales were low and the model was discontinued in 2014.





## χV

In the same year, Subaru joined forces with Toyota to develop a common car, the Subaru version being sold as the BRZ, with rear wheel drive breaking with tradition.

### BRZ

In 2020 Subaru introduced hybrid versions of the Forester and the XV, joining the hybrid fraternity long after many other manufacturers. However they weren't very popular partly due to having a very small battery and low powered electric motor. Reduction in fuel consumption was claimed as 14% in the city, but negligible in country driving, and with a purchase price increase of \$3500 for an XV.



### Solterra

Subaru's latest foray into the electric market is the fully electric Solterra, jointly developed with Toyota and arriving in Australia in March this year. It appears to be a capable vehicle, but with a recommended price of \$75,000 for a base model and \$82,500 for the Touring model, it may be out of reach of many customers.

In recent years, Subaru has placed a strong emphasis on safety, environmental consciousness, and innovation. As with many manufacturers, it has introduced many features dependent on advanced electronics to make the driving experience more comfortable and pleasurable – if you can work out which button to push.


