



AFTER A SLIGHTLY LATER FINISH TO THE WORK DAY THAN PLANNED CHERYL I LEFT MT BARKER JUST AFTER 3:30PM TO MEET EVERYONE AT THE CAMBRAI PUB. ARRIVING JUST AFTER 5 WE WERE GREETED BY PAUL AND THERESA SHINKS, DEBBIE CLEMENTS AND RICHARD TEMPLE. WITH ADRIAN (OUR GUIDE) RUNNING A LITTLE LATE WE LEFT AT 5:20 TO MAKE OUR WAY TO CAMP, STOPPING OFF AT THE



SEDAN PUB TO MEET ANOTHER PERSON FROM TAFE SA WHO WOULD ALSO BE JOINING US FOR THE WEEKEND.

WE GOT TO CAMP JUST AFTER DARK AND GAVE EACH OTHER A HAND TO GET SET UP, WE HAD SOME DINNER AND PILED INTO THE SHINKS' CAMPER FOR A COUPLE OF DRINKS AND A CHAT.


