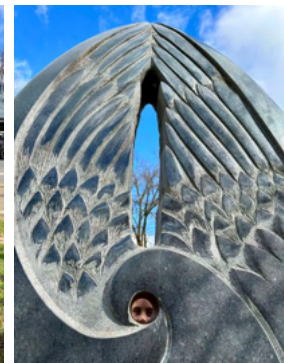
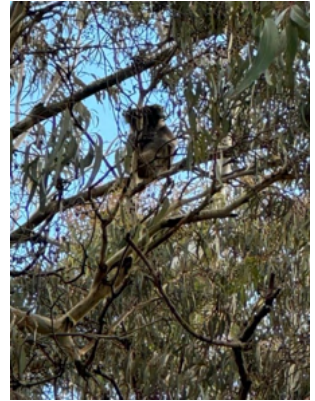

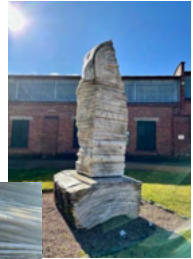
TRIP REPORT:

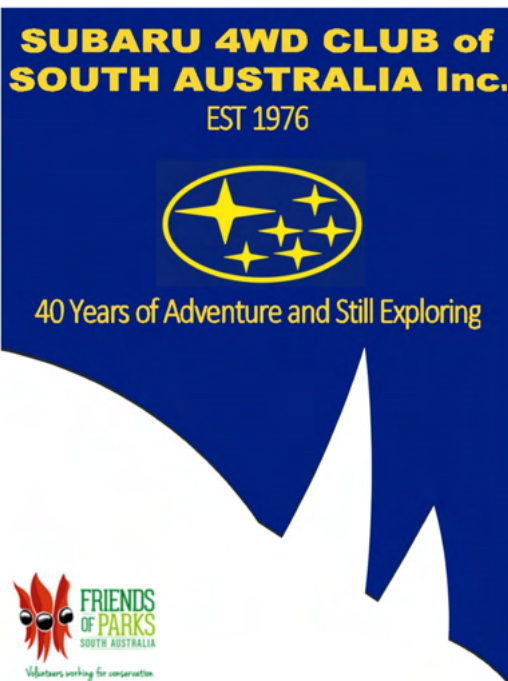
