Who's looking after your eyes?

PRESENTATION SUMMARY

Our vision plays a crucial role in education, employment, communication, driving, and daily navigation. Vision loss can significantly impact health, independence, and overall quality of life.

Refractive error measures how well your eyes focus. An optometrist can prescribe glasses or contacts to improve nerve over time, leading to peripheral vision, addressing issues like blurriness, eye strain, headaches, and double vision.

Cataracts cause the eve's lens to become cloudy, impairing clear vision, often due to aging, family history, UV exposure, smoking, diabetes, or steroid use. Optometrists monitor cataract progression, adjust glasses, provide vision enhancement tips, and refer to specialists for surgery when needed.

What can we do ...?

- Regular comprehensive eve tests by an Optometrist
- Good management of blood pressure, cholesterol and blood sugar
- Stop smoking
- Maintain a good diet
- Regular exercise
- Know your family eve history
- Ask a support group for more information

Glaucoma results from disrupted eye fluid regulation, damaging the optic vision loss. Optometrists can detect it early to prevent further vision loss.

Age-related macular degeneration

(AMD) leads to a gradual loss of central vision, impacting activities like reading, watching TV, and recognizing faces, while peripheral vision remains unaffected. AMD doesn't result in complete vision loss, but its progression varies, with some experiencing slow or no impact on vision and others facing faster vision loss in one or both eyes.

Diabetic Eye Disease occurs when someone has diabetes and their blood sugar and blood pressure is not well controlled. This starts to damage the small blood vessels at the front and back of the eye, which can then bleed, become blocked or leak fluid. Diabetes can also cause cataracts and glaucoma. Diabetic eye disease can lead to both central and peripheral vision loss if not detected early and treated.
